## Sponsorship Money

### What does the sponsor fee pay for?

All sponsor money is used to send one  
boy and one girl to the Jr. Golf  
International Golf tournament at Doral  
Resort in Miami Florida.

The winner of the boys 16-18 and girls  
15-18 age group in the Jr. Golf  
Tournament qualifies to go to the  
international tournament. The sponsor  
fee goes to pay for the expenses of  
these golfers.

### What are the costs for the international tournament?

Entry fees for the tournament are  
\$730.00 per golfer for a total of  
\$1,460.00. This includes Tournament  
Entry Fee, Golf-tournament rounds  
(practice rounds not included), 5  
nights lodging, 5 breakfasts and 4  
dinners, and access to all Special  
Events.

Round trip airfare at \$1200.00 per  
golfer at current rates for a total of  
\$2,400.
